

Lisa Blatt Recognized as 2020 *Law360* Appellate MVP

Each year, *Law360* names practice area “MVPs” as “an elite group of attorneys who are leaders in their practice areas and have seen extraordinary wins in the past year.” This year, *Law360* recognized **Lisa Blatt** among its 2020 Appellate MVPs. *Law360* highlighted Lisa’s three U.S. Supreme Court victories last Term, including *United States Patent & Trademark Office v. Booking.com*, where the Court ruled 8-1 in favor of firm client Booking.com and held that the addition of “.com” to a generic term can create a protectable trademark. In her interview with *Law360*, Lisa was asked to reflect on her career and what motivates her: “I just love being an advocate and fighting for a client,” she said, adding that she was motivated to “ensure that those around her – particularly her female colleagues – were getting argument opportunities,” in light of the small percentage of women arguing before the Supreme Court.

Lisa serves as Chair of Williams & Connolly’s **Supreme Court and Appellate Litigation** practice. She has argued 40 cases before the United States Supreme Court, prevailing in 37, more than any woman in U.S. history.* *The National Law Journal* has called her a “visionary” and one of “the 100 most influential lawyers in America.” *Bloomberg* has described her as a “legendary high court litigator,” while *The National Journal* likewise has referred to her as a “SCOTUS legend.”
